

HND students could progress further on the BA (Hons) Fashion Design or equivalent, depending on the match of the HND units to the degree course in question.

Entry Requirements

Age

- Minimum 18 years old

Academic entry requirements

- Higher National Certificate (HNC) in Fashion and Textiles (or equivalent Art and Design pathway) achieved at PASS or above.
- Level 2 literacy and numeracy (or equivalent).

Language proficiency

- IELTS 5.5 (min. 5.0 in each component)
- PTE 51 (min. 51 in each component)
- TOEFL (IBT) 87 – min. L-21, R-22, S-23, W-21

Non-academic entry requirements

All applicants need to attend an interview and bring a portfolio of work that demonstrates a range of creative thinking and technical skills applied to your chosen subject or other design-related projects.

You will also undertake a literacy and numeracy diagnostic test.
